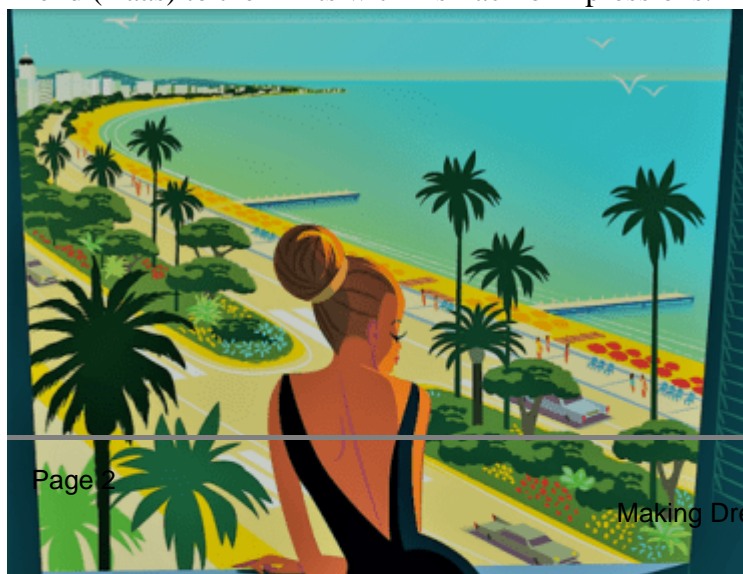
Los Angeles, April 10, 2020 — In celebration of short film and
